

Our run/walk-a-thon is a fun and fit activity for students and supporters, with all participants striving to achieve their personal best distance. Participants should set realistic lap goals based on age and development. Drinks will be provided and awards given for exceptional participation.

Rules

1. Participants may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. **Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be brought in on the day of the run/walk-a-thon, Saturday, 2/13/16.**
2. Pledges may be made by anyone. **Each sponsor making a pledge should print their own name, pledge per mile and maximum pledge.** *Participants may collect the donation in advance but must hold the money until all other pledge monies are collected.*
3. On the day of the run/walk-a-thon event, each participant will run/walk during a specified time. Each participant will be issued a "lap tag," which will be punched each time the participant reaches the starting point, thereby keeping track of the distance completed.
4. Upon completion of the run/walk-a-thon, participants will hand in their lap tags. A volunteer will record each participant's lap total on their pledge sheet and return it. Participants may then collect outstanding pledges. If a sponsor would like to request a receipt, one will be provided via email after the date due.
