RE: Acceptance of Escambia County Ordinance No. 2018-19

Dear Chairman Bergosh:

On April 17, 2018, your Board of County Commissioners enacted Escambia County Ordinance No. 2018-19 in which it conferred certain franchise rights and privileges unto the Town of Century to provide natural gas utility service to those portions of northern Escambia County. We understand that the Ordinance was filed with the Florida Department of State on April 18, 2018. Section 11 of the Ordinance provides that as a condition precedent to it taking effect, the Town of Century shall file its acceptance thereof with the Escambia County Clerk of the Court within one hundred twenty days "after its enactment of this franchise by majority vote of the governing body of Grantee and filing with the Department of State."

I am pleased to advise that at its meeting on May 57, 2018, the Century Town Council formally accepted Escambia County Ordinance No. 2018-19. By copy of this letter to the Escambia County Clerk of Court, the Town of Century is hereby filing with her office this acceptance of Escambia County Ordinance No. 2018-19.

The City appreciates the opportunity to provide natural gas utility service to the residents, businesses, and general public within the franchise territory.
