  - **Event Time:** Set up starting at 3 PM
  - **Fireworks Display:** At Dusk
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### Vendor Categories

The Town of Century welcomes applications from the following vendor types: - Food trucks and food vendors - Artisan and craft vendors - Retail and merchandise vendors - Nonprofit and community organizations

*Vendor mix will be curated to avoid duplication and ensure a positive experience for attendees.*

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## Vendor Fees

Vendor Type	Fee
Food Vendors / Food Trucks	\$50
Artisan / Craft Vendors	\$25
Retail / Merchandise Vendors	\$25
Nonprofit / Community Organizations	\$10

*Fees may be adjusted at the Town's discretion.*

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## What Vendors Receive

- Designated vendor space within Anthony Pleasant Park
  - Inclusion in event promotions (as space allows)
  - Opportunity to sell goods or distribute information
  - Access to a large, family-friendly audience
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## Vendor Space & Setup

- Vendor spaces are approximately **10' x 10'** (food trucks may vary)
  - Vendors must provide their own tents, tables, chairs, extension cords, and weights
  - All tents must be properly weighted (minimum 40 lbs per leg)
  - Setup times and load-in instructions will be provided prior to the event
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## Utilities

- **Electricity:** Limited availability (must be requested in advance)
  - **Water:** Not guaranteed
  - Generators must be quiet and properly secured
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## Food Vendor Requirements

Food vendors must: - Hold a valid Florida Department of Business & Professional Regulation (DBPR) or Department of Health permit - Comply with all Escambia County Health Department regulations - Display all required permits at the event - Provide proof of liability insurance (if required)

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## Non-Food Vendor Requirements

- Vendors are responsible for collecting and remitting any applicable sales tax
  - Vendors must comply with all local and state regulations
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## Insurance & Liability

The Town of Century may require vendors to provide proof of general liability insurance naming the Town of Century as an additional insured.

Vendors may be required to sign a **Release, Indemnification, and Hold-Harmless Agreement** prior to participation.

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## Rules & Regulations

- Vendors may not sublease or share space without prior approval
  - No amplified sound without Town approval
  - Vendors must remain set up until the conclusion of the fireworks display
  - No alcohol sales unless properly licensed and approved
  - Vendors are responsible for keeping their area clean
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## Application Process

To apply as a vendor: 1. Complete the Vendor Application Form 2. Submit required permits and documentation 3. Submit vendor fee payment

**Application Deadline:** June 30th, 2026

Vendor acceptance will be communicated via email.

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## Cancellation Policy

Vendor fees are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled by the Town of Century.

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## Release, Indemnification & Hold-Harmless Agreement

This Release, Indemnification, and Hold-Harmless Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into by the undersigned Vendor (“Vendor”) in connection with participation in the **Town of Century 3rd of July Fireworks Celebration**, to be held on July 3, 2026 at Anthony Pleasant Park, Century, Florida.

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### Assumption of Risk

Vendor understands and acknowledges that participation in this event involves inherent risks, including but not limited to personal injury, property damage, or loss. Vendor voluntarily assumes all such risks.

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### Release and Waiver

Vendor hereby releases, waives, and discharges the Town of Century, its elected officials, officers, employees, agents, and volunteers from any and all claims, demands, actions, or causes of action arising out of or related to Vendor’s participation in the event.

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### Indemnification

Vendor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Town of Century and its representatives from any claims, damages, losses, liabilities, or expenses (including reasonable attorney’s fees) arising from Vendor’s acts or omissions, including those of its employees, agents, or representatives.

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### Insurance

Vendor agrees to maintain any required insurance coverage and provide proof upon request. Vendor understands that failure to provide required insurance may result in denial of participation.

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## Compliance with Laws

Vendor agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and health and safety requirements.

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## Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
